Please review this list to be sure you do not accidentally give our patients any item that may risk the safety of the patient you are visiting, any other patient, your safety, any other visitors' safety, and/or staff's safety. *Some of these items, if necessary for the patient to use, can be stored at the Nursing Station, but please understand you should give these items to the staff, and if deemed necessary, staff will then supervise the patient with the item.*
